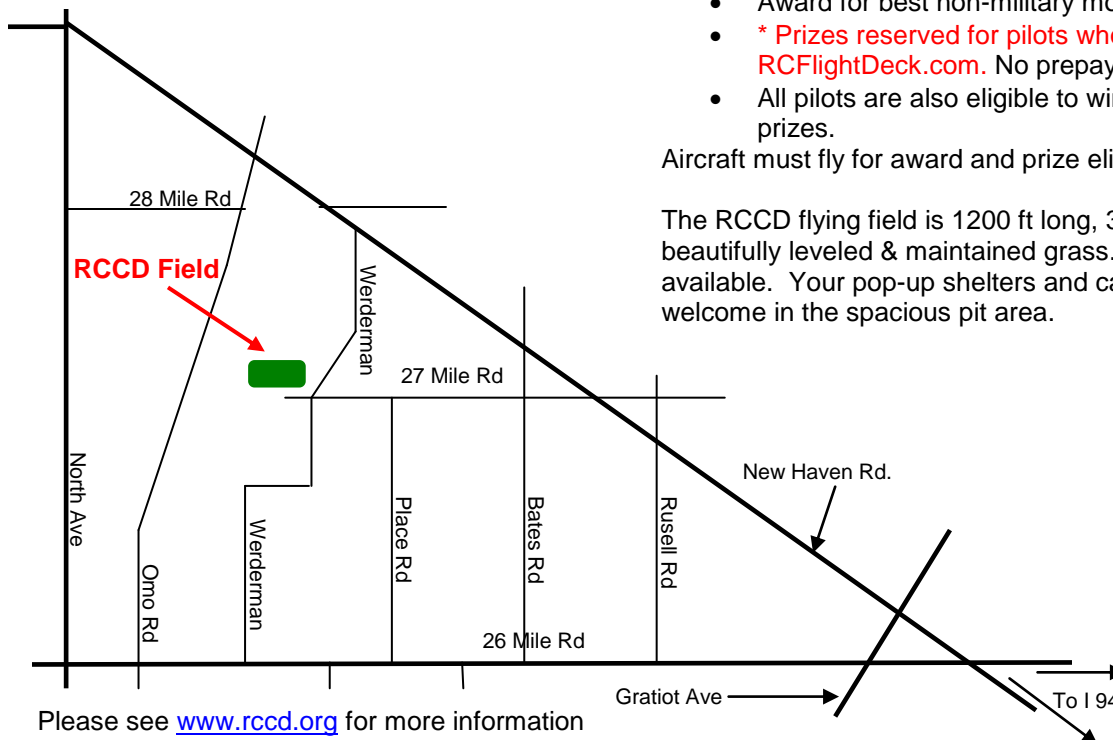


Awards and Prizes:
