- Landing Fee (for pilots): \$10 per pilot

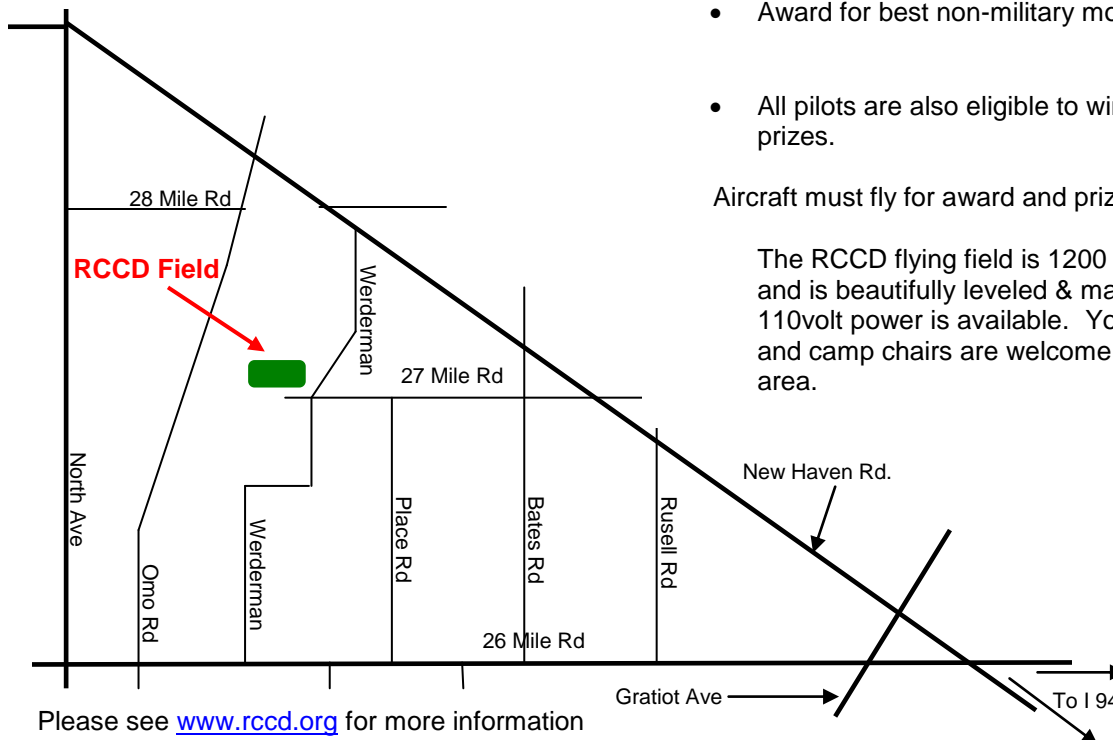


### Awards and Prizes:
