

Project Improvement

When I converted my power supply I used a 100 ohm / 0.3 amp. adjustable rheostat (potentiometer) instead of the fixed resistors that were recommended, that way I would be able to dial in the exact voltages. (5 volt and 12 volt). In the photographs you can see how it was mounted, also I put an access hole in the cover so I could make the adjustments. I used wire leads with connectors on the ends and I also made up a variety of adaptor wires to fit all my different batteries.

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
