

## 6-6-19 update #2 FIELD MOWING AND FIELD CLEAN-UP SCHEDULE

On Friday 6-7-19 @ 10:00 am the field is scheduled to be mowed by the grass cutting team. If soil conditions allow, the field will also be rolled where possible.

On Saturday 6-8-19 @ 10:00 am a field clean up and field prep will be held. There is a need for at least 10 club member volunteers to do the work where the tractors can not reach or repairs made to tire ruts. Bring your own weed whip, push or self propelled grass mower and supplies for your equipment; and brooms, rakes, along with boots, gloves, and safety glasses.

On Wednesday 6-12-19 @ 10:00 am the field is scheduled to be mowed by the grass cutting team. If soil conditions allow the field will also be rolled where possible. This will be the last attempt that will prepare the field for the War Bird and Scale Event to be held on Saturday 6-15-19....RAIN OR SHINE.

The above notice was posted on the club website on 6-6-19. and an email was sent to all the club members. Regarding this schedule. The notice was deleted from the website when the the cancellation of the event was posted on Monday 6-10-19.

The original schedule above was altered as noted below:

The work scheduled for Friday 6-7-19 @10:am was completed by the grass cutting team (without the field rolling due to the soil conditions). The tractor battery was dead when trying to start the tractor at the storage area and a new battery was purchased at Tractor Supply early Friday morning and installed before all the work was started.

The work scheduled for Saturday 6-8-19 was completed on Friday 6-7-19 due to additional club member volunteers showing up. They worked hard and completed the work that was scheduled for Saturday. A notice was posted on the club website and an email notice sent to all the club members regarding what happened.

The work schedule for Wednesday 6-12-19 was canceled due to the new battery purchased on Friday 6-7-19 was completely dead when the tractor was to be moved from the storage area. It will be replaced by Tractor Supply.

NOTE: Even though the next scheduled event held at the field isn't till July 13, 2019, The grass cutting team will continue to try to stay ahead of "Mother Nature" regardless of all the rain and soil set backs we have been encountering.
