COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan

Name of Flying Club: Radio Control Club of Detroit

I am the Representative for Radio Control Club of Detroit which operates a model airplane flying club at Wetzel State Park/Recreation Area. Most use of the flying fields is individual and not more than 10 individuals. I will be committed to ensuring safe use of the flying field by implementing the following processes to stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

- No gatherings over 10 people will be allowed.
- Before any person enters the flying field, individuals will make a self-evaluation for virus symptoms. Through self-evaluationary COVID-19 symptoms (including a person with a temperature exceeding100.4) will not enter the premises. Reference response plan if any symptoms are detected.
- A daily cleaning will be performed on all common touch areas that members of the public could potentially come in contact with including fencing, seating, etc.
- Before touching any common touch points (gates, fencing, doors/handles, lawn care
 equipment, etc.), hands will be sanitized with a hand sanitizer which is60% alcohol
 based or greater. While on the premises, hand sanitizing will be encouraged often.
- After use, all lawn care equipment will be disinfected with an EPA approved cleaner.
 The person who sanitized equipment will wear disposable gloves while disinfecting the
 equipment and placing the equipment back into storage of uploading for removal from
 the site.
- 6-foot distancing will be practiced by all members not from the same household.
- A bottle of hand sanitizer with a minimum of 60% alcohol level will be available to club members for use. Use will be encouraged.
- Signs or placards will be posted the flying fields which reference covid-19 health practice requirements in and around the structure.

Covid-19 response plan if suspected or detected:

• If I experience any symptoms or come in contact with the COVID-19 VIRUS, the Park Manager will be immediately notified. I will seek medical attention from my doctor and seek council from his professional advice and follow upon it.

- All common surfaces at the flying fields will be immediately cleaned and sanitized by a club member that is symptom free.
- After a 14-dayself-quarantine for symptoms and using professional advice with a release from a medical professional, I will be able to resume entry the flying fields.
